WHEREAS, the District has an opportunity and obligation to honor the traditions of our organization and consider the best interests of our community into the future; and


WHEREAS, the District has an opportunity and obligation to be proactive in providing the highest level of service for our community;

3. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect and be enforced immediately upon its approval by the Board.




